The hotel doesn't provide a shuttle service. Taxi and Uber are excellent options. Depending on traffic, the transfer from Toronto Pearson International airport will take between 30-45 minutes and costs around \$50 + tip. The transfer from Billy Bishop (Toronto Island) airport will take about 4 minutes and costs around 14\$ + tip.
